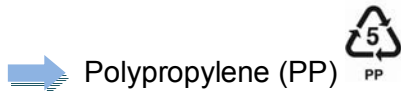


Selling Your Waste Plastics to ENKO® – What you Need to Know

ENKO® recycles two kinds of plastics in high volumes, but we would also consider purchasing other types of waste plastics.



The information listed below is aimed to point out the areas ENKO® looks at before evaluating all new supplies of waste plastic. Before purchasing any post-consumer or post-industrial plastic, ENKO® would also require a sample of the material offered.

- **Material Consistency, Quality and Standards**
 - The origin of the material should be known to seller. Only non-toxic plastic is accepted. (based on EU directive 1013 of July 2007, origin documentation needs to be provided by seller)
 - Batches should be separated by type of material (PP, HDPE, etc.)
 - Material should be free of metal particles, sand, paper, and oils
 - Material should not be damaged from overexposure to weather elements (rain, sun, etc.)
 - It is preferable if the material is sorted by colors (white, yellow & orange, red, green, blue, and black), but this is not a requirement
- **Volumes and Frequency of Delivery**
 - Although we prefer regular supplies of material from consistent sources, we would also consider one-off batches of reasonable quantity
- **Packaging and Transportation**
 - Material can be either crushed and bagged in “big bags” or baled
 - We prefer to buy material FOB Plovdiv, Bulgaria, but in some cases we can also collect the material from customer’s site if it is appropriately packaged
- **Price**
 - Different grades of plastics have different market values, so price paid depends much on all the factors listed above
